

GOOD RED

Good Red 2005 - Napa Valley:

- *Blend Composition: Merlot 67%, Sangiovese 24%, Zinfandel 5%, Syrah 4%. 100% Napa Valley appellation*
- *This Merlot/Sangiovese blend is a Californian rendition of an Italian “Super-Tuscan” style wine.*
- *Winemaking: The grapes used to make this wine were gently destemmed, and placed in small, open-topped fermentors where the fermentation proceeded to extract color and flavor for in excess of 21 days. After pressing, the wine was placed in small, French and American Oak barrels for 18 months prior to bottling.*
- *Tasting notes: The 2005 Good Red – Napa Valley is a beautiful combination of aroma and flavor. It possesses a spicy cinnamon cherry nose with deep plum and coffee flavors. The palate is round and rich; redolent of the earth from which the grapes emanated. The entry is of ripe fruit and the finish is long and lingering with mocha and toasted oak notes. It will pair with a great variety of foods including grilled chicken and pork, pasta dishes and aged cheeses.*
- *Alcohol: 14.2%*
- *Good Red SRP is \$9.99 to 12.99... A wine that over-delivers at this price!*
- *The Good Red & Good White labels are bottled under the brand, “Wine for Good” (WFG). WFG was created with the simple goal of providing Good wines at a Good price for a Good cause. Good Red was the first wine in the WFG series. 50 cents of every bottle sold is donated to Children’s Health Charities important to each region WFG is sold. Good Red 2005 – Napa Valley, is now the third release of Good Red. The year 2007 marks the inaugural vintage of Good White.*
